The SPCA has partnered with the HOPE Foundation to transport animals to Fresno twice a month. Dogs and cats stay overnight, and return the next day. Rates are very affordable and there is no income eligibility. The SPCA offers vouchers for TNR of feral cats, and has periodic free male cat neuter clinics in town at specified locations.
