Notes:

1. The bus stop at the GET Downtown Transit Center is located on Chester Avenue in front of the facility.
2. Bus stops directly in front of Berean Bookstore on Wible, between Ming and Wilson, slightly south of the GET Southwest Transit Center.
3. Bus will stop south of the Mobil gas island at the rest stop.
4. Bus will stop in front of the Chevron fuel price sign across the street from the T/A Truck facility.
5. REQUEST ONLY STOPS
6. Bus will make stops as requested in the Frazier Park area.
7. BHS bus stop is the same as the GET bus stop on the south side of the campus on California Avenue.
8. Medical trips must transfer to the Regional Transit Medical Dial-A-Ride bus in Bakersfield. There is no charge for transferring to the Medical Dial-A-Ride. The Medical Dial-A-Ride bus will provide dropoffs and pickups to any medical facility in the Greater Bakersfield area. ALL MEDICAL TRIPS WILL REQUIRE RESERVATIONS AT LEAST ONE DAY IN ADVANCE.

■ **Local Dial-a-Ride:** RESERVATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED AT LEAST ONE DAY IN ADVANCE IN ORDER TO GUARANTEE YOUR RIDE. Service is on a first come, first served basis. Those calling without a one day reservation will not be guaranteed a ride. Operation of the dial-a-ride service is provided Monday through Saturday (holidays excluded) from 7:00 am to 5:30 pm. The service area includes Lebec, Frazier Park, Lake of the Woods, Pinon Pines and Gorman. For reservations call 1-800-881-5787.

■ **Service To/From Bakersfield:** All service is on a first come, first served basis. Service is provided Monday through Saturday (except holidays) as per the times noted on the schedule.

■ Dial-A-Ride passengers may board or debark the bus at any safe location within the service area. Service is curb-to-curb only.

■ Service will be provided on paved and maintained roads only, weather conditions permitting. **No service will be provided on dirt, gravel or non-maintained roads.**

■ Service **WILL NOT** be provided on the following days; New Years Day; Easter; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day; Thanksgiving Day; and Christmas Day.

■ Smoking, eating, drinking and the playing of audio equipment are not permitted on the bus.

■ Shirt and shoes are required to ride the bus.

■ Unruly persons are not permitted to ride the bus. Obscenities are not allowed.

■ Do not block the exit. When boarding the bus, please step to the rear of the bus and leave front seats vacant for persons who are elderly or have a disability.

■ All buses are accessible to the disabled and equipped with wheelchair lifts.

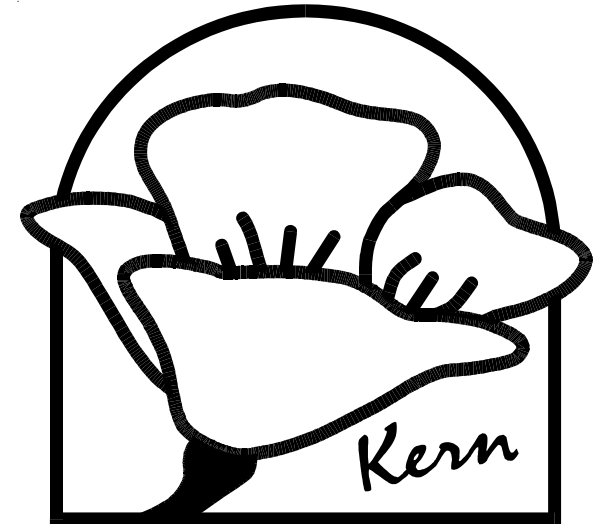
■ Passengers requiring transportation for medical appointments can transfer to the Regional Transit medical dial-a-ride upon arrival in Bakersfield. There will be no extra charge for transferring. **RESERVATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED AT LEAST ONE DAY IN ADVANCE IN ORDER TO GUARANTEE YOUR RIDE FOR THE BAKERSFIELD MEDICAL DIAL-A-RIDE.** Service will be on a first come, first served basis. For reservations, call 1-800-881-5787.

■ Buses equipped with bicycle racks may be used by passengers at their own risk. If unfamiliar with operation, please ask driver for instructions. Driver will not load or unload bicycles for passengers. Bicycles left on bus will be released to the Kern County Sheriffs Dept. if unclaimed.

■ **Pre-Paid Fare Tickets:** Fare tickets may be used in lieu of cash. Ticket booklets can be purchased by mail or in person at the Kern County Public Services Building on the first floor from the Cashier. For order information, call or write to:
