

FARE INFORMATION

Because of the long distances involved with the Kern River Valley area, fares are based on two zones. The use of zones simplifies the fare structure for you as well as the bus driver. Zones change in Lake Isabella. An additional fare is charged for travel between these zones. From Kernville, the zone will change if you travel past the County complex. From Onyx, the zone will change if you travel past Lake Isabella on Hwy 155.

ZONE 1

Lake Isabella/Bodfish, Mtn. Mesa, Southlake, Weldon and Onyx

ZONE 2

Lake Isabella/Bodfish, Wofford Heights and Kernville

All service is on a first come, first served basis.

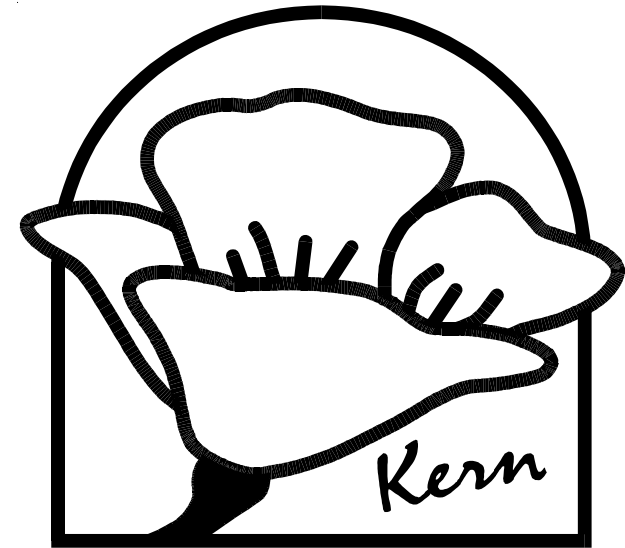
- Service consists of both Intercity Fixed-Route and Dial-A-Ride service. Passengers may board or disembark the bus at any safe location within the service area. Dial-A-Ride service is curb to curb only.
- The Dial-A-Ride service area will be up to 2 miles off the intercity route. **DIAL-A-RIDE SERVICE WILL NOT BE PROVIDED ON UNPAVED ROADS, NON-MAINTAINED ROADS, OR WHEN UNSAFE CONDITIONS EXIST.**
- For trips to Bakersfield, you may need to transfer at the Veterans Hall/Senior Center transfer site.
- Service is from Monday through Saturday (holidays excluded).
- Service **WILL NOT** be provided on the following days; New Years Day; Easter; Memorial Day; Independence Day; Labor Day; Thanksgiving Day; and Christmas Day.
- **FOR DIAL-A-RIDE SERVICE, RESERVATIONS WILL BE REQUIRED AT LEAST ONE DAY IN ADVANCE IN ORDER TO GUARANTEE YOUR RIDE.** Those calling without a one day reservation will not be guaranteed a ride. Service will be on a first come, first served basis. For reservations, call **1-800-881-5787**.
- Smoking, eating, drinking and the playing of audio equipment are not permitted on the bus.
- Shirt and shoes are required to ride the bus.
- Unruly persons are not permitted to ride the bus. Obscenities are not allowed.
- Do not block the exit. When boarding the bus, please step to the rear of the bus and leave front seats vacant for persons who are elderly or have a disability.

- All buses are accessible to the disabled and are equipped with wheelchair lifts.
- Discounted fares will only be given to customers possessing a Kern Regional Transit Discount Fare Card, Valid State ID, VA Card or Medicare Card. Applications are available from the bus drivers or from:
